

# Class Environmental Assessment Geraldton Water Pollution Control Plant Upgrades

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC CONSULTATION CENTRE #2

The Municipality of Greenstone (the Municipality) is planning to expand its existing sewage collection system to accommodate the Greenstone Gold Hardrock Mine project temporary construction camp. The existing Geraldton Water Pollution Control Plant (WPCP) is nearing its Certificate of Approval-rated capacity, and improvements will be needed to accept additional flows from the temporary construction camp, and eventually from planned growth areas within the Municipality. There are also some existing areas at the Geraldton WPCP where improvements will take place, such as legacy process equipment and plant configuration from the previous expansion, and outfall pipe flow restrictions to Hardrock Creek.

The Municipality has evaluated potential alternative methods to identify the preferred solution that will address the current and future population's needs compared to the Geraldton WPCP's existing capacity and conditions (the study). The study is being conducted as a Schedule C project, as outlined in the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment guidelines (as amended in 2007, 2011, and 2015).
