

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF GREENSTONE

BY-LAW 15-81

Being a By-law to amend By-law 05-27
(Procedures for the Procurement of Goods and
Services by the Municipality of Greenstone)

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001*, c. 25, Part VI, Section 271(1) as amended states that a municipality shall adopt policies with respect to its procurement of goods and services;

AND WHEREAS on the 13th day of June 2005, Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Greenstone enacted By-law 05-27, being a By-law to provide for the Procedures for the Procurement of Goods and Services by the Municipality of Greenstone

AND WHEREAS a Council may amend By-laws in accordance with the *Municipal Act*;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the Municipality of Greenstone strives to be an accessible Municipality that is inclusive to all people with disabilities;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it necessary to amend By-law 05-27 to incorporate accessibility features into the procurement and acquisition of goods and services By-Law in accordance with the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA);

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF GREENSTONE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **THAT** By-law 05-27 be amended to include:

2. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

h) to have regard to the accessibility for persons with disabilities to the goods and / or services purchased by the Municipality of Greenstone, as well as to the Procurement Process itself.

3. GUIDELINES

When purchasing goods and services, the Municipality of Greenstone will incorporate accessibility design, criteria, and features. Where applicable, Procurement documents will specify the desired accessibility criteria to be met and provide guidelines for the evaluation of Bids in respect of those criteria. Where it is impractical for the Municipality to incorporate accessibility criteria and features when purchasing specific goods and services, a written explanation will be supplied upon request.
