

GENERAL

- is responsible for the delivery of appropriate recreational day camp activities
- is responsible for the supervision, safety and light maintenance of play areas.

QUALIFICATIONS

- must be a person who is and who will continue to be a student at a school, college, university or other educational institution.
- must be 16 years of age or turning 16 by December 31
- possess first aid & CPR certificate or willing to obtain.
- have the ability to communicate their ideas, lead and organize activities and be a positive role model for children.
- must be responsible, enthusiastic, motivated and have patience with children.

REPORTING

reports to the Daycamp Supervisor.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- responsible for ensuring the safety, well-being, participation of all children enrolled in the Day Camp Program on assigned sites or at special events.
- Presentation and coordination of an age appropriate daily Day Camp Program comprised of activities such as sports, games, crafts, dance, activities and special events.
- attend and participate in mandatory training sessions.

HOURS OF WORK

 available to work a 40-hour week for 8 weeks in July & August each summer.

CLOTHING

- must wear appropriate clothing while working with children.
