

NOTICE OF PUBLIC CONSULTATION CENTRE



Municipality of Greenstone Landfill Environmental Assessment

The Corporation of the Municipality of Greenstone has initiated a study under the *Environmental Assessment Act* to review alternative options for municipal solid waste management within the Municipality. The need for the study is as a result of the closure of several rural MNR owned landfill sites and the limited remaining lifespan of the existing Geraldton Ward landfill site.

The first step in the process is the preparation of a terms of reference (ToR). The ToR sets out the proponent's framework and work plan for addressing the *Environmental Assessment Act* requirements when preparing the environmental assessment, including such things as the alternatives that will be considered and the public consultation activities that will be carried out.

A draft ToR has been prepared and is currently available for review on the project website (www.greenstone.ca).
