Questions received as of 9:17 a.m. on March 5, 2018 regarding the RFP – Outdoor Billboard Signs. The following clarification supersedes the RFP document issued on February 26, 2018. Please acknowledge receipt of this Addendum by inserting its number and date on the RFP proposal.

Question:

- 1) In situations where you are replacing entire sign structures, are they all to be wood or is the preference aluminum or steel? In using your mapped locations, there appear to be different types of structures for the existing units (images below).



Response:

When erecting entire sign structures, materials used should be sustainable to all weather conditions and appropriate for supporting the attached sign.

Question:

- 2) If you but do not require engineering, do you have existing base spec's that should be reused in cases where an entire structure needs to be replaced?

Response:

No, we do not have existing base spec's. The base is to be structurally sound and capable of supporting the attached 8' x 8' sign.

Question:

- 3) Is the head section of the board to be made solely of wood, or again is there a preference for aluminum or steel? Given no engineering is required, we want to ensure we correctly spec based on what end product is expected.

Response:

The head sections of the board, as well as the end product of the structures, are to be constructed of materials sustainable to all weather conditions and appropriate for supporting the attached sign.
