

Riverview Hiking Trail



Camping and Boating

This fully equipped campground is located in the community of Longlac, beside the Kenogami River. The park offers a place to camp, fish on the river and hike on the Riverview Hiking Trail.



Entrance

The start of the trail is at the North end of the campground and is identified by a large trail head sign. The trail itself is two kilometers (1.2 miles) in length and is perfect for a leisurely stroll.



Kenogami River

Evidence of the past logging operations can be seen along the river in the form of large groups of logs driven into the riverbed and then bound together.

Boreal Lowlands

Elevated boardwalks allow users to walk through the wet forest without disturbing the ecosystem. This forest is the home to unique plant and wildlife species that are described on the interpretive signs along the trail.



Black Boxes?

Throughout the trail you may spot thin black boxes located up in the trees. These are the daytime retreats for bats which eat thousands of flying insects every night.

Viewing Platform

The two-tier viewing platform provides a place to sit and rest while you look out over the Kenogami River. If you look south down the river, in the distance you can see the old church which sits on the shores of Long Lake.
