GENERAL

The Greenstone Community Services Department requires a temporary full-time Specialized Transportation Driver. Specialized transit is a shared ride, door-to-door, pre-booked service where registrants can book trips in advance, and are assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis. The Municipality of Greenstone operates two transportation programs: Rural Transportation in Geraldton and Longlac; whereby, eligible riders are transported to the grocery store, pharmacy, post office, etc. and Aging at Home Transportation; whereby, eligible riders within the Municipality of Greenstone are transported to in town and out of town medical appointments (Thunder Bay or equivalent distance).

- Vulnerable Sector Police Record Check
- Current First Aid and CPR Certificate
- Bilingualism will be considered an asset.
